

Memberships in Rainbow Bridge

Rainbow Bridge is open to all individuals who subscribes to our Vision and Mission. There shall be the following types of membership.:

1. **Ordinary membership** is open to all **Malaysian** They must be 18 years and above. They should reside in Malaysia, are allowed to vote and are permitted by the Registrar of Societies (RoS) to hold office. They are required to fill in the Membership Application Form, pay the prescribed entry fee and the application is approved by the RB Committee.

Ordinary members are:-

- a. required actively participate in at least one RB project within a year of joining
 - b. should actively invite friends and family to be RB members if they share our ideals
 - c. are encouraged to nominate potential Beneficiaries
 - d. are encouraged to nominate corporate businesses, foundations and professionals to be Sponsors or as Corporate Members
 - e. are encouraged to nominate institutions, sports associations to be Collaborators
 - f. are encouraged to make donations to support the work of RB
 - g. are encouraged to make donations for specific RB approved projects and encourage friends to do so
2. **Associate membership** is opened to all individuals who are non-citizens of Malaysia as is determined by RoS Malaysia. Apart from this, Associate Members will also be guided by requirements above.
 3. **Corporate membership** is open to any corporate entity or association that shares the same objectives as Rainbow Bridge and wishes to actively declare its support as well as participate in the activities carried out by RB. Corporate Members may nominate up to a maximum of three persons to be RB ordinary or associate members, at no extra charge.
 4. **Honorary membership** is awarded to individuals who have shown their evidence of their active commitment to humanity services to society and/or contributed significantly to the advancement of civic society or the betterment of the nation. To be a honorary member of RB, the candidate must be nominated by a member of RB and seconded by two other members and the nomination must be approved by at least two-thirds of the sitting RB Committee.
 5. **Youth membership** is opened to any individual of age 17 and below. The individual should provide evidence of active participation in humanitarian activities, preferably in an organising role. Youth members are required to fill in the Youth Membership and be nominated an RB member and required the required entry fee. Youth members are required to show evidence of participation in at least one RB project per year.
